GUIDELINES FOR AGENCIES REQUESTING GRANTS

WSA Grants are awarded to programs and activities that alleviate human suffering and directly affect persons who are disenfranchised by poverty or are underserved, primarily in our community but also in our nation and the world.

Grants are awarded only to qualified nonprofit 501(c) (3) organizations.

Grants are not made to political action or legislative advocacy groups.

Grants are made only to organizations that have other sources of financial support.

Applications may be submitted throughout the year.

Grants are made for a period of one year. Organizations may reapply for support in subsequent years. Such applications must include an account of the impact of the previous WSA award on the work of the organization and the degree to which the goals established for activities supported by the grant were met.

Applications are reviewed by the WSA each month. Applicants should expect a waiting period before they receive notification.
